Holiday Decor

FRIENDLY REMINDER:

- Winter holiday lighting and décor should be removed from the exterior of the home no later than the 2nd weekend of January
- If not removed by February 1st, RSO will be sending out Friendly Reminders to have it removed within 48 hours.
- All other holiday décor should be removed within 10 days after the holiday.





Guest Pass

- Please note the MCBH Base Order regarding base access for guests has changed
 - Please refer to this order for updated guidelines
- Any guest staying in your home longer than 72 hours needs to be registered with PMO and written approval from your RSO must be obtained
 - Additional items will be needed for guest staying longer than 14 days and guests staying more than 30 days





Vehicle Parking and Guidelines

- Use driveway and garage for parking whenever possible
- Undesignated parking spots should not be used on a consistent basis
 - Vehicles should be moved regularly
- All vehicles in family housing must be in good operating order and must have a valid and current safety inspection sticker and current tags
- Resident is responsible for keeping assigned parking areas such as garages and driveways clean of oil and debris
- Residents are not permitted to store vehicles for other people or grant others to park in the neighborhood
- Boats, trailers, recreational vehicles, and oversized vehicles are not permitted in the neighborhoods at any time without written permission from the RSO





Picking Up After Your Pet

- Pet owners are not permitted to leave pet waste droppings anywhere in the neighborhood or common areas
- Dog owners should carry disposable bad and clean up after their animal
 - Dispose of pet waste bag in proper trash receptacles
- Pet waste should be picked up daily from fenced in yards
