Exterior Lighting

Did you know that all of our homes are equipped with a photo cell exterior safety light?! Yes, this is a great safety feature for your home. This light is typically located next to your garage and you may discover that you can't find a light switch to control this light feature. These lights are ran by a photo cell, so that your light will automatically turn on at night as the sun is setting and will automatically turn off as the sun rises in the mornings. These lights are a safety feature for both you and your neighbors. Does your exterior light not work? If you find that this light is out on your home please contact our work order dispatch at 808-839-4357 or use the Rent Café app to submit a work order and our friendly maintenance team would be happy to assist with getting this feature working again for your home.
