# COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS

## Bulk Trash Pick-up

### Regular Trash - One (1) trash bin per household.

Trash must be out before 7:00 AM on the day of trash pick-up or after 6:00 PM the night before. Place on curb at least 4 feet away from vehicles and other objects. In order for the trash to be picked up, the trash bin lid must be completely closed. Items placed next to bin won't be picked up.

### Bulky Trash

Bulky items, only. No cardboard, construction, or green waste. Large items (like satellite dishes) must be broken down. No automotive parts, propane tanks, oil, paint, antifreeze, or household chemicals. No regular trash.

Any extra trash bags that do not fit in your bin can be disposed of at the nearest refuse station on the island. If you have any questions, please contact your Resident Services Office at (808) 470- 5400.


