The HMC Foundation scholarship program assists active-duty Service Members, National Guard, or Reservists of one of the five branches of the United States Armed Services or their dependents who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs.

Landscaping Progress: Keeping MCBH Green

We're thrilled to report significant progress in our landscaping efforts. As of now, 70% of backflow repairs are complete. This marks a crucial step in revitalizing our irrigation system and ensuring that our community remains lush and green, especially as we transition from the rainy season into the new year. HVAC System Replacement at Mololani: Enhancing Comfort & Efficiency

In other great news, we are on track to complete a significant capital project this January at Mololani: the replacement of over 330 HVAC systems. This initiative not only demonstrates our commitment to maintaining and improving the infrastructure of our homes but also highlights how effectively we utilize Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) funds for these vital upgrades. These new systems will not only enhance the comfort of our residents but also contribute to greater energy efficiency across the community.

Annual Preventative Maintenance: A Friendly Reminder

As we strive to maintain the highest standards of living, we remind all residents that annual preventative maintenance is essential and will commence shortly. This routine upkeep is crucial for ensuring the longevity and functionality of our homes.

BAH Increases for 2024: What It Means for Our Community

The Department of Defense (DoD) has announced a 5.4% increase in Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) rates for 2024, effective from January 1, 2024. This adjustment aims to cover approximately 95% of housing costs, including rent and utilities, across over 300 military housing areas.

Key Highlights:

- In 2024, the military will allocate about \$27.9 billion in BAH to roughly one million service members.
- There is an increase of +\$71.7 million in the BAH program compared to FY 2023.
- Service members will not experience a decrease in their BAH rates if they maintain uninterrupted eligibility in a given location.
- A demotion will result in BAH adjustment to the rate corresponding to the lower paygrade.
- Upon promotion, your BAH will not decrease; you will receive the higher rate between your old and new paygrades.

This increase in BAH is a significant development for our residents, as rent in PPV housing is equivalent to the BAH rate. We're committed to ensuring that these changes are implemented smoothly and beneficially for our community. We thank you for your continued cooperation and participation in making our community a wonderful place to live.
