MAINTENANCE TIPS

AC Reminders for a Cool and Comfortable Home: Following these simple tips will help your AC run efficiently and keep your home cool all summer long.

- **Filter Maintenance:** Regular filter changes are crucial for maintaining good indoor air quality and keeping your HVAC system running smoothly. If you have pets, it is recommended to change your filters twice a month.
- Consistent Temperatures: Maintain a consistent thermostat setting throughout the day. Turning it off during the day or while you're away can make the system work harder to cool down the house again, causing potential issues. It is recommended to keep the fan set to "auto".
- Setting Your Thermostat: Keep your thermostat at or above 72 degrees. Generally speaking, an air-conditioning system is designed to accommodate up to a 20-degree difference between the inside air of your home and the outside air. The age and construction of your homes are potential variables in this rule. Setting the temperature too low can cause the unit to freeze up and the system will stop cooling.
